Manuscripts must be sent by e-mail by **8 January 2025** in a word format, to the three editors: <u>cosmin.goian@e-uvt.ro</u>, <u>loredana.tranca@e-uvt.ro</u> & <u>florina.vlaicu@e-uvt.ro</u>. Articles are subject to a double-blind peer review process. The editorial team makes the first selection of articles, before sending the articles to at least 2 reviewers. Articles are accepted on the basis of adequacy, clarity, sound methodology and usefulness for social practice, research and education.
