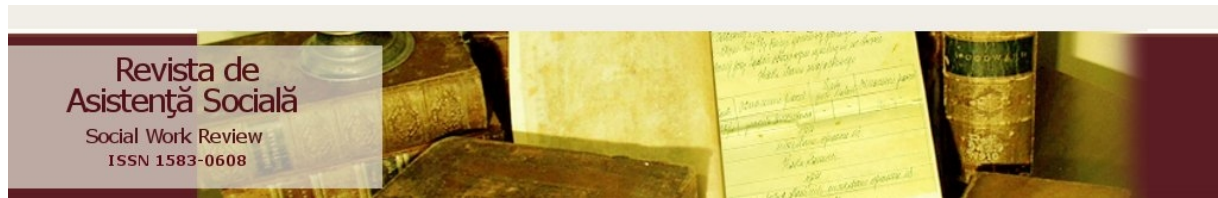

The received articles are subject to a double-blind peer review process. The editorial staff makes the first selection of articles before sending them to at least 2 reviewers. The articles are accepted on the basis of adequacy, clarity, solid methodology and utility for social practice, research and education.
