

Call for papers for the Social Work Review Issue 1/2022

Dear colleagues and collaborators,

We invite you to contribute with your articles to issue 1/2022 of the Social Work Review (http://www.swreview.ro/index.pl/home_en), a scientific, BDI indexed journal (ProQuest, EBSCO, Social Work Abstracts, CEEOL, Index Copernicus, SCIPPIO, GESIS, IBSS, Erih + and accredited B+ by CNCSIS), published by the University of Bucharest, Faculty of Sociology and Social Work in partnership with Polirom publishing house. It is intended to be a means of disseminating research, good practices, experiences in the field of social work, but also policies, serving as a tool for social change.

Issue 1/2022, edited by Prof. Cosmin Goian, PhD and Lect. Loredana Marcela Trancă, PhD, from the Department of Social Work at the West University of Timișoara, is destined to the **Research Perspectives on the social protection of people with disabilities.**

We welcome innovative articles in English and / or Romanian, research, comments on policies, practices and their implications for social workers in the field of social work for people with disabilities, as well as other theorists and practitioners in fields related to social work.

For this issue we propose the following topics, without limiting ourselves to them: current social policies, strategies and programs for national, regional, county or local development, in the field of disability; protection and promotion of the rights of persons with disabilities; prevention of poverty and the risk of social exclusion of people with disabilities; quality of life of people with disabilities; current changes and models of good practice in social work for people with disabilities; management systems in socio-medical services; community issues specific to social work of people with disabilities; financing social services; contracting social services; early intervention; social participation of people with disabilities; employment; continuing education and training among people with disabilities; social work for people with disabilities and assistive technology; inclusive life; migration; substance use; bullying; social justice; the social impact of the COVID 19 pandemic.

Assessment of papers by reviewers: December 15, 2021

Receiving final articles: January 10, 2022

Estimated publication date: March 2022

Manuscripts must be sent by e-mail by the deadline in word format, respecting the requirements of the journal (http://www.swreview.ro/index.pl/conditii_de_publicare_ro), to the two editors: cosmin.goian@e-uvt.ro and loredana.tranca@e-uvt.ro. Articles are subject to a double-blind peer review process. The editorial team makes the first selection of articles, before sending the articles to at least 2 reviewers. Articles are accepted on the basis of adequacy, clarity, sound methodology and usefulness for social practice, research and education.
